

CITY OF VON ORMY, TEXAS

ORDINANCE NO: 2010-36-A

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE MAYOR TO DELIVER A STATE OF THE CITY ADDRESS; PROVIDING THAT THE MAYOR PRO TEM DELIVER THE ADDRESS DURING THE INCAPACITY OF THE MAYOR; ESTABLISHING THE DUTY TO FILE THE ADDRESS WITH THE CITY CLERK; AND DICTATING THE MANNER OF DELIVERY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Von Ormy deems it necessary and proper for efficient and effective government of the city that a State of the City Address be delivered by the Mayor annually, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to provide the residents of Von Ormy with greater communication, and;

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Von Ormy finds it worthy to present a State of the City Address to the residents of Von Ormy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VON ORMY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. MAYOR REQUIRED TO DELIVER STATE OF THE CITY

The Mayor of the City of Von Ormy is hereby required to deliver a State of the City Address in the month of February each year.

SECTION 2. INCAPACITY OF THE MAYOR

If the Mayor of the City of Von Ormy is unable to deliver a State of the City Address due to illness, absence, military service or other incapacity, the duty shall fall upon the Mayor Pro Tem.


SECTION 3. FILING OF ADDRESS

The State of the City Address shall be delivered in writing to the City Clerk in February of each year. The City Clerk shall keep a permanent record the said address in the City Archives.


SECTION 4. MANNER OF DELIVERY

The Mayor shall deliver the State of the City Address orally during a regular scheduled meeting of the City Council in the month of February each year. The City Council may change the manner of delivery by an affirmative vote of the Council for any given year.
