ORDINANCE NO: 2010-36

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A REDUCTION OF SPEED ZONE ALONG RIFE LANE PROVIDING A SPEED LIMIT OF TWENTY FIVE MILES PER HOUR; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

WHEREAS, §545.356(b-1) of the Texas Transportation Code has provided authority for cities to adopt ordinances for speed limits;

WHEREAS, the City Council of Von Ormy has determined the current speed limit along RIFE LANE, a two lane, undivided highway, is unreasonable and unsafe.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VON ORMY TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1: **SPEED ZONE ESTABLISHED: RIFE LANE** is hereby reduced from 30 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour; and

Section 2. **PENALTY:** Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than \$100.00 or more than \$200.00. Each violation shall constitute a separate offense.


Section 3. **SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, phrase, sentence or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distance than independent provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** That the City of Von Ormy City Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause this ordinance to be published in every issue of the official newspaper for two days; or one issue of the newspaper if the official newspaper is a weekly paper. This ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders, and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect when the publication requirement is satisfied.
