

# CITY OF VON ORMY TEXAS

## ORDINANCE NO. 2010-58

---

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VON ORMY, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF STREET FROM OLD QUINTANA ROAD TO HERNANDEZ LANE; PROVIDING A REPEALING AND SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Von Ormy has deemed it appropriate to change the name of street from Old Quintana Road to Hernandez Lane; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Von Ormy has determined that renaming the street from Old Quintana Road to Hernandez Lane is consistent with the goal of street names within the community of Von Ormy and is in the best interest of the City; and

**NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF VON ORMY**


**SECTION 1.** The Name of Old Quintana Road shall be changed to Hernandez Lane along the location shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto. The maps and records of the City need to reflect the change in street name herein and to cause appropriate signage to be erected.

**SECTION 2. SAVINGS/REPEALING CLAUSE.** All provisions of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent a prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the ordinance. Any remaining portions of said ordinances shall remain in full force and effect,


**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.** Should any section, subsection, sentence clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, the City of Von Ormy hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance is to become effective the date of its passage.

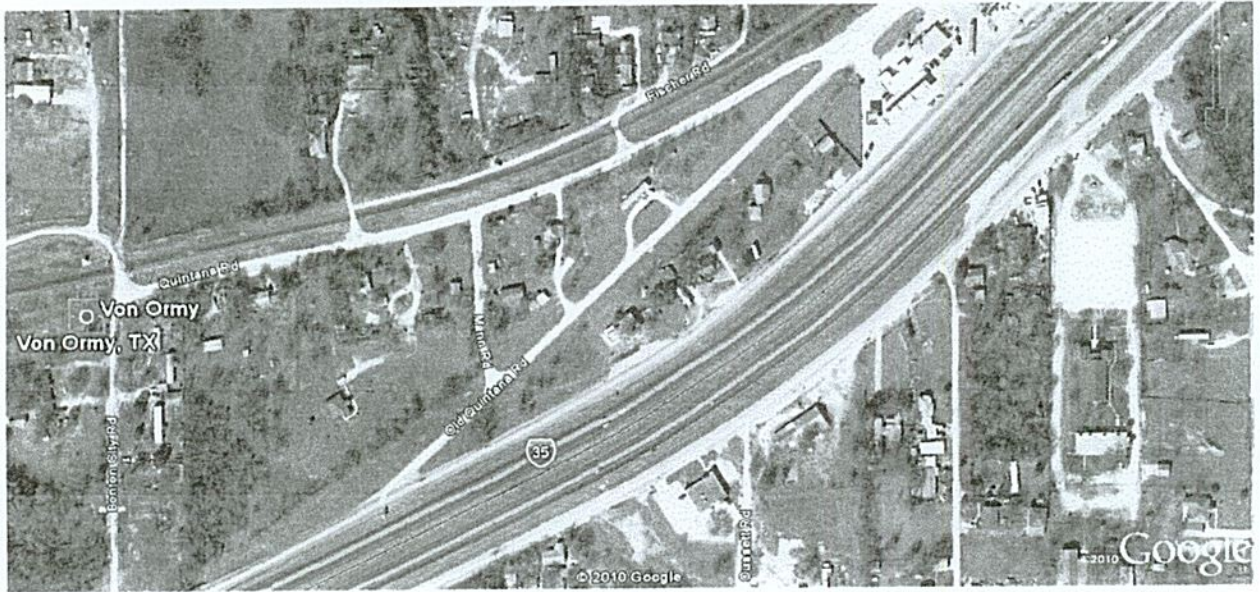
