ORDINANCE NO. 2011-63

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION ORDINANCE;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of Von Ormy finds the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance shall be amended to appointing Edward de la Garza as the Floodplain Administrator and the removal of Julia A. Hernandez. The Ordinance previously adopting the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance shall stay in full force an effect; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration Edward de la Garza shall be appointed as Floodplain Administrator for the City of Von Ormy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VON ORMY TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: DESIGNATION OF THE FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR

Section 12 of the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance is hereby amended to appoint Edward de la Garza as the Floodplain Administrator to administer and implement the provisions of this ordinance and other appropriate sections of 44 CFR (Emergency Management and Assistance - National Flood Insurance Program Regulations) pertaining to floodplain management and Julia Hernandez, City Clerk, is hereby removed as Floodplain Administrator.


SECTION 2: SAVINGS/REPEALING CLAUSE. That all provisions of the ordinances of the City of Von Ormy, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, phrase, sentence or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distance than independent provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


SECTION 4: The City Clerk of the City of Von Ormy is hereby directed to publish notice of this Ordinance as required by the laws of the State of Texas.
