## ORDINANCE NO. 2011-64

---

### **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BURN BAN ORDINANCE NO. 2008-10; SAVINGS/REPEALING CLAUSE; SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS, the City of Von Ormy finds the Burn Ban Ordinance shall be amended to allow the Mayor and/or designee to declare a Temporary Burn Ban; and**

**WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Von Ormy, Texas, in order to preserve and protect the public health, safety, and welfare, deems it necessary and appropriate for Mayor and/or designee to declare a Temporary Burn Ban.**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VON ORMY TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1: DURATION OF BAN.** A Temporary Burn Ban may be issued by the Mayor and/or designee upon an emergency and/or hazardous situation as determined by the Mayor and/or designee. Upon the declaration of the Temporary Burn Ban by the Mayor and/or designee the Mayor and/or designee shall have such Temporary Burn Ban confirmed by the Von Ormy City Council at the next regular or special City Council meeting.


**SECTION 2: SAVINGS/REPEALING CLAUSE.** That all provisions of the ordinances of the City of Von Ormy, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, phrase, sentence or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct provision and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**SECTION 4:** The City Clerk of the City of Von Ormy is hereby directed to publish notice of this Ordinance as required by the laws of the State of Texas.

**SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance is to become effective the date of its passage.
